1	Alignment	Provide an alternate route that moves away from 290 at Patton Ranch Rd and is on the north side of Williamson Creek, splitting to a connection to 71 and then back to 290 at "the Y"	1
2	Alignment	Depress US 290 between RM 1826 and SH 71	2
3	Alignment	The US 290 terminus should go past Circle Drive - RM 1826 is not logical	3
4	Alignment	End US 290 just west of RM 1826 near Hudson Loop	5
5	Alignment	Depress US 290 at SH 71	5
6	Alignment	Provide a 1-level interchange at "the Y"	5
7	Alignment	Provide bridges over US 290 at Convict Hill Rd., Oak Meadow Dr., SH 71, and William Cannon Dr.	5
8	Alignment	Provide a crossing under US 290 for Patton Ranch Road connecting to Joe Tanner Lane	5
9	Alignment	Provide a U-turn under US 290 at Joe Tanner Lane	5
10	Alignment	Provide an alternate route for US 290 connecting to MoPac. It leaves the existing corridor just east of Circle Drive.	6
11	Alignment	Provide alternative access between RM 1826 and Convict Hill Rd.	6
12	Alignment	No signals or Frontage Roads along US 290 from RM 1826 to the existing US 290 freeway	6
13	Alignment	Depress US 290 from RM 1826 to west of "the Y"	7
14	Alignment	Elevate US 290 from west of "the Y" to east of William Cannon Dr. on a new alignment north of Williamson Creek	7
15	Alignment	Provide a new alignment for SH 71 east of Williamson Creek with connectors to existing SH 71. The eastbound connector would be at-grade, located against the cliff.	7
16	Alignment	Provide a new a US 290 route north of Williamson Creek with the SH 71 connection along the existing highway. Possible names included: the Big Split, the Cannonball, the Shotgun, and the Laser.	8
17	Alignment	Consider a bridge for William Cannon Drive over US 290.	8
18	Bike/Pedestrian	A Williamson Creek trail was marked along the creek	4
19	Bike/Pedestrian	A bike crossing was requested at US 290 at Patton Ranch Road	4

26	Environmental	Noise and "dark sky" light are issues along 290 from 1826 to William Cannon. Would be worse if the highway was elevated.	2

28	Environmental	Locations of large oaks, sweet gums, and pecan trees were identified	2
29	Environmental	Noise, light, "dark sky", air quality are issues along US 290 between RM 1826 and Willaim Cannon Drive	4
